"Staying with a host family made my whole study abroad experience 100 times better. Our host mom was always so welcoming and now I have a new family in Spain!"

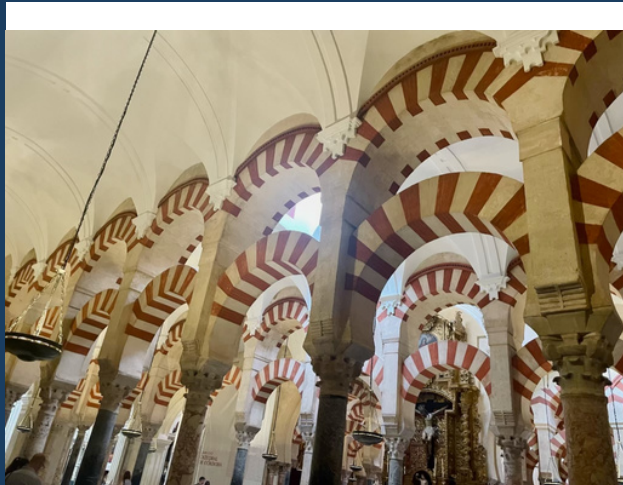
